



Gift Aid Declaration

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, the Trust will receive an extra 25 pence. This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid.

You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April next) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that the Trust will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
